

Minutes from Feb. 10 and March 10, 1998 Council meetings:

Congregational Meeting - same day as 125th Anniversary of Church - presented by Ed Myers.

Sunday - September 27, 1998 from 1 - 6 p.m.

Place: North Point Gardens (on hold)

Price: \$27.20 per person includes tips

\$ 8.75 per head open bar

\$35.95 per person

Darlene motioned, John seconded, all in favor.

Band: \$450.00 - Tommy Thomas - 4 hours of playing

\$300.00 - Impacts, 3 piece band

Tommy Thomas not available for playing. Therefore, Impacts is selected for this occasion. Olga motioned, Darlene seconded for Impacts.

Gifts will be given out at this celebration. Ed Myers needs help with helpers and Committee members. See Ed to volunteer. Cut off day to volunteer helping - March 15, 1998. All Committees will need to pick a Chair-person.

Ed Myers presented: Need to stress to Congregation - responses are needed as soon as possible. Suggest advertising in newspaper - we may get more responses. Depending on responses will depend on celebration.

Seventeen people have responded so far. Time is running out! Darlene recommended sending a letter out before Committee Chairpersons are selected.

Additional Update: We have a contract on the hall, North Point Gardens. Hall #1 holds 180 people, Hall #2 holds 450 individuals. We have a one week time period to change head count. Suggestion made - change to Hall #1.

Ed stated individuals think \$35 is too much especially if large family. Decision was made to cut open bar to wine, beer and set-ups. \$28.80 per person if we cut back. It's possible to decrease to \$25 per head.

Band is all set - deposit will need to be sent out.

Chairpeople are needed to handle Committees: If no one comes forward as Chairpeople - may as well scrap whole idea. There will be approximately \$720 the Church will need to absorb.

Pastor Armstrong recommended having individuals present special ideas/speeches to encourage individuals to attend.
